



Investments in global health programs may have benefited health but not necessarily capacity for knowledge generation in LMICs.




Figure 3 Percentage distribution of lead and last authorship of community health worker publications by income classification [n=649]. HIC, high-income country; LIC, low-income country; MIC, middle-income country.

Keep the same standards of quality research

 Authorship is a measurable yet imperfect metric of inclusion in research

• Recognizing the two sides of the coin:

High **demand** (for publication in HIC) while Little recognition is given to capacity building

Little local investment to support career development and to build the articulation skills needed for proposal and paper writing and research leadership.

What can make the international research ethical?

- OConducting research in low and middle income countries can be a successful experience if conducted ethically.
- OUnderstanding the context can make us actors of change and development
- OInvesting more in the capacity building of the local researcher's contribution in generating the evidence and not merely in collecting the data.
